

Lieutenant Colonel Micheal McKenna

Lt Col Michael R. McKenna is Commander of the 34th Combat Training Squadron, Little Rock Air Force Base, Arkansas. The 34 CTS executes Air Mobility Command's only Joint Accredited exercise program, focused on training Mobility Air Forces on intra-theater airlift operations, personnel recovery, and joint mission planning. The squadron is comprised of 14 different functional specialties across two geographic locations, including Aircrew, Intelligence, Command and Control, Air Mobility Liaison Officers, Logisticians, and Survival/Evasion/Resistance/Escape Specialists. On average, the 34 CTS annually trains over 15,000 Airman, Soldiers, and international partners through the Joint National Training Center and Air Mobility Command's STORM FLAG exercises and leads mobility forces' integration with the US Army's Joint Readiness Training Center at Fort Johnson, Louisiana.

Lt Col McKenna is a 2007 graduate of the United States Air Force Academy. He attended pilot training at Naval Air Station Pensacola, Florida and Naval Air Station Corpus Christi, Texas. After completing C-130J initial qualification training he was stationed at Little Rock Air Force Base, Arkansas – where he attended the United States Air Force Weapons Instructor Course – and then Dyess Air Force Base, Texas. Lt Col McKenna has served in a variety of positions



both in garrison and deployed including: Director of Operations for the 744th Expeditionary Airlift Squadron, Wing Chief of Tactics, Chief of Current Operations, Assistant Director of Operations, and Squadron Chief of Standardizations and Evaluations. Lt Col McKenna attended the US Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas prior to his staff assignment at HQ Pacific Air Forces to lead Combined/Joint Exercise Planning and Execution in the USINDOPACOM theater of operations.

Lt Col McKenna is a senior pilot with 597 combat hours and over 2,800 total flight hours. He has participated in the U.S. Global War on Terrorism with three deployments in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM and Operation INHERENT RESOLVE.
