# LIEUTENANT COLONEL RICHARD S. KERR

Lieutenant Colonel Richard S. Kerr is the Commander, 43d Operations Squadron, Pope Army Airfield, North Carolina. The squadron is responsible to combatant commanders to facilitate rapid outload and projection of the XVIII Airborne Corps' Immediate Response Force from Pope Army Airfield as the operations arm of Air Mobility Command's Task Force Gryphon. The squadron provides 24/7/365 airfield operations, Joint Forcible Entry exercise support, tactics, joint airdrop inspection, en route ops, and records management for Team Pope's Special Warfare Airman.

Prior to assuming command, Lieutenant Colonel Kerr served as the Chief of Safety for the 43d Air Mobility Operations Group. In this role, Lieutenant Colonel Kerr oversaw the flight, occupational and weapons safety program for more than 2,600 Airman and civilians on Pope AAF.

Lieutenant Colonel Kerr was commissioned in the Air Force in 2005 after graduating from the United States Air Force Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in History. He then completed Undergraduate Pilot Training at Vance Air Force Base in 2007 and began flying the C-17A. Lieutenant Colonel Kerr obtained a Master of Arts in Political Science from the American Military University in 2013.



Lieutenant Colonel Kerr served in the 613 Air Operations Center, Air Mobility Division, providing Command and Control support for mobility aircraft and aircrew assigned and in support of US INDO-PACOM. Prior to his current assignment, Lieutenant Colonel Kerr was the Director of Operations for the 57<sup>th</sup> Weapons Squadron, C-17 Weapons Instructor Course. While there he was responsible for producing C-17 Weapons Officers and Weapons Instructors. Lieutenant Colonel Kerr is a C-17 Instructor Aircraft Commander and US Air Force Weapons Officer with over 3,400 hours in the C-17A aircraft. He has flown 955 combat hours in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, NEW DAWN, and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL.
