



LIEUTENANT COLONEL RYAN E. DONOHOE

Lieutenant Colonel Ryan E. Donohoe is the Commander, 49th Combat Training Squadron, Pope Army Airfield, North Carolina. The Combat Training Squadron plans, hosts, and executes 4-6 exercises every year. These large-scale exercises provide full spectrum high-end joint combat training for joint and international participants. They range from multi-aircraft service level events at Pope to integrating with large combatant commander exercises spanning multiple areas of responsibility.

Before command, Lieutenant Colonel Donohoe was the Director of Operations for the 43d Operations Support Squadron at Pope AAF. This squadron is responsible to combatant commanders to facilitate rapid and precise outload of the XVIII Airborne Corps' Immediate Response Force from Pope Army Airfield's Green Ramp.

Lieutenant Colonel Donohoe commissioned through OTS in June 2005 at Maxwell AFB, AL after graduating from the Georgia Institute of Technology with a bachelor's degree in Computer Science. He graduated from Joint Specialized Undergraduate Navigator Training in June 2006 and C-130 Initial Qualification Training in February 2007. In 2018, he was the Lead Airlift Planner for RED FLAG — Alaska and the



Director of Operations for the354th Operations Group Detachment 1. Following that assignment, Lieutenant Colonel Donohoe was an IDE Student at Air Command and Staff College, Maxwell AFB, AL. He returned to Alaska as the Combat Operations Division Chief, 611th Air Operations Center, JB Elmendorf – Richardson, Alaska, one of three Joint Air Operations Centers conducting NORAD and NORTHCOM Homeland Defense and Northern Sovereignty Operations.

Lieutenant Colonel Donohoe has deployed four times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Inherent Resolve. During Operation Inherent Resolve, Lieutenant Colonel Donohoe served as an Air Advisor to the Iraqi Air Force during the Battle of Mosul against ISIS. He has over 1950 hours in the C-130 E/H.
