



## MASTER SERGEANT JESSICA L. STACY

MSgt Jessica Stacy is the Senior Enlisted Leader, 43d Operational Support Squadron, Pope Army Airfield, North Carolina. As superintendent she serves as key advisor to the commander for all enlisted development matters. The squadron is responsible to combatant commanders to facilitate rapid outload and projection of the XVIII Airborne Corps' Immediate Response Force from Pope Army Airfield as operations arm of Air Mobility Command's Task Force Gryphon. Additionally, she oversees execution of 24/7/365 airfield operations, Joint Forcible Entry exercise support, tactics, joint airdrop inspection, en route ops, and records management for Team Pope's Special Warfare Airmen.

Sergeant Stacy entered the Air Force in May 2008. She completed Enlisted Undergraduate Aircrew Fundamentals and Basic Loadmaster Courses before graduating C-130H Initial Qualification in March 2009. She has served 15 years in various positions as a C-130H/J loadmaster instructor and evaluator at Dyess Air Force Base, Little Rock Air Force Base, and Joint Base San Antonio. She has supported Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and NEW DAWN, and establishment of the Indian Air Force's C-130 Functional Check Flight Program. Prior to her current position Sergeant Stacy served as C-130 Command Examiner Loadmaster in A3 Standardizations and Evaluations, 19th Air Force, Joint Base San Antonio Randolph, Texas. She represented 3,800 aircrew as Air Education and Training Command's C-130J/H Subject Matter Expert, developed enterprise-level policy directing \$2.5B in flying training operations across 2 wings, and oversaw 115 formal aircrew training courses generating \$1.7B in Flying Hour Programs while serving as MAJCOM Inspector General's Pertinent Oversight Authority ensuring units' regulatory compliance with Higher Headquarters' directives.
