Who we are: The Air Force's Violence Prevention Program focuses on the primary prevention of interpersonal violence (child abuse, dating violence, domestic violence, workplace violence, sexual assault) through program development and teaching prevention strategies within Team Pope and throughout our local community.

Who we support:

We work directly with commanders, helping agencies and other group staff agencies to support over 2,600 personnel from four Major Commands and 20 associated tenant units and their families.

Our accomplishments:

Due to the Violence Prevention Integrator position sitting unfilled for a long period of time, the office is excited to be back on its feet. We have much yet to be accomplished!

What we do: We implement violence prevention strategies for Domestic Violence, Sexual Violence, Suicide Prevention, Teen Dating Violence and Child Abuse Prevention.

How we tie into the greater mission:

The Violence Prevention Program focuses on non-clinical and integrated primary prevention of interpersonal and self-directed violence. This involves an integrated, multiagency, and collaborative approach with other DAF programs on primary prevention efforts to contribute to the overall well-being of the Total Force.

Our challenges:

The Violence Prevention position has no operating budget. Since inception, these fiscal requirements have come out of the resilience budget.
