Mission:

Enhance mission readiness and foster a drug-free environment through education, prevention and deterrence.

Vision:

Maintain the health and wellness of a fit and ready fighting force as well as a drug-free Air Force

Priorities:

Deter the Use and Abuse of Drugs, Assist Commanders in Assessing Risk, Detect and Identify Drug Use

Who we are:

We are a focal point for installation drug testing and prevention supporting over 2500 Airmen, their families and Department of the Air Force Civilians.

What we do:

We perform management of all aspects of the installation Drug Demand Reduction program to include budget and military & civilian drug urinalysis testing programs.

Who we support:

We support all AF units on Team Pope, including our AF mission partners outside the 43d AMOG and local ROTC units.

How we tie into the greater mission:

The Drug Demand Reduction Program directly impacts mission readiness. The presence in the military environment of persons who engage in drug abuse seriously impairs accomplishing the military mission and is a threat to the health, safety, security and welfare of the total force and therefore is not compatible with service in the Air Force.

Our accomplishments:

This year we have tested over 2,400 military and civilian members, and we have verified five positive cases.

Our challenges:

Testing every member per year.
