Mission:

Propel a trusted workforce through continuous vetting and counterintelligence... optimizing the protection of critical assets

Vision:

Trustworthy, Reliable Airmen willing and ready to protect National Security

Priorities:

Keep Commanders Informed, Manage Security Clearance Operations, Support Information Requests

Who we are:

Our office consists of one Civilian who directs, administers, and oversees the Component's Information, Personnel, and Industrial security programs.

What we do:

We provide oversight to support group requirements and recurring education and training. We provide advice, assistance, and guidance on security matters to all unit security managers regarding all aspects of Information Protection, and ensure maximum effectiveness of the programs. Present security material and distribute pertinent security information as applicable.

Who we support:

The IPO directly supports the 43 AMOG Squadron Commanders, the ACC and AETC tenant unit Commanders, and provide fingerprinting services to AFROTC cadets and AFSOC personnel to expedite security clearance submissions.

How we tie into the greater mission:

The serving IPO reports directly to AMC Director of Information Protection as well as the Defense Counterintelligence Security Agency. Systems and procedures are established to track/monitor security incidents involving classified information, as well as personnel security incidents involving derogatory information.

Our accomplishments:

We have the Fundamentals of Suitability Training complete with 50 PDU's (of 100) accomplished towards certification renewal.

Our challenges:

Manpower and the absence of physical security support.
