Who we are:

We are a small team of safety focused professionals, specializing in ground/occupational, weapons/explosives, and flight safety.

Who we support:

We support all Air Force members on Team Pope, including our tenant organizations. We accomplish this in two methods - as Commanders' advisors and through Guidance to Airmen. We are here to primarily provide the AMOG Commander with safety focused advice; however, we also advise Squadron Commanders.

Our accomplishments:

We have been named award winners at multiple levels in and out of our organization, including the 2019 and 2021 Air Mobility Command Flight Safety NCO of the Year, and the 2020 Air Mobility Command Safety Office of the Year.

What we do:

We provide strategies to Commanders to manage risk. This includes helping to ID and develop methods to mitigate risks in order to preserve warfighting capabilities and resources.

How we tie into the greater mission:

Our Ground/Occupational Safety ensures there is a safe working environment to enable Airmen to execute the mission. Our Weapons Safety provides the capability to maintain, transport and utilize weapons and explosives safely. Finally, our Flight Safety develops and maintains an environment for safe air operations.
